Scholars Program Internal Application Process

The School of Theatre & Dance Graduate Committee recognizes the following process as the method by which all students who wish to participate in the Scholars Program apply.

- 1. Students who are potential candidates can self-identify or be identified by faculty.
 - a. Students must have completed 85 units to apply, and ideally not more than 105
 - b. Students must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or in the last 60 semester units
 - c. Students MUST be majoring in Theatre Arts
- 2. Students download the application from the Scholars Program website: https://grad.sfsu.edu/content/scholars-4-1-program
 - a. Direct link to form: <u>https://grad.sfsu.edu/sites/default/files/documents/sf-state-scholars-application.pdf</u>
- 3. Using the suggested road map (<u>https://grad.sfsu.edu/sites/default/files/documents/theatre-arts-roadmap-color.pdf</u>), students may work with their regular undergraduate advisor to prepare and complete the application. However, the faculty advisor **SHALL NOT SIGN** the form at this time.
- 4. The student and faculty advisor will identify a writing sample to submit with the application. Ideally, this is from GWAR or similar writing-intensive course.
- The faculty advisor will upload the application and writing sample to the iLearn forum labeled "Scholars Program Applications" under the label *Graduate Committee* on the School of Theatre & Dance iLearn site.
- 6. The faculty advisor will notify the Director and Chair of the Graduate Committee that they have uploaded documents for review.
- 7. The Graduate Committee will examine the uploaded documents and make a determination on the suitability of the student for the Scholars Program.
 - a. If the documents show suitability, the Graduate Committee may ask the student to meet with the Graduate Committee.

- For Fall semester entry into the Scholars Program:
 - Upload to iLearn by April 15 (or first business day thereafter)
- For Spring semester entry into the Scholars Program:
 - Upload to iLearn by November 15 (or first business day thereafter)
